



# Annual Report

FYE 2022

As part of a national organization of 120 chapters of Assistance League, our mission is to serve our local communities with cutting edge programs to ensure those most in need are served directly.

Last year our members donated 9,987 hours of service to enrich the lives of thousands of school children and families in Los Gatos, Saratoga, Monte Sereno, Campbell and San Jose. Assistance League is an all-volunteer non-profit with no paid staff and minimal overhead. 87% of every dollar we spend was returned to the communities we serve.

## In Our Past 19 Years We:

- Served 145,000 clients
- Contributed 295,000 hours of volunteer service
- Returned **\$1.3 Million** to our local communities

## Accomplishments in 2021-2022:

- 420 books were distributed to 30 classroom libraries. Students were also given 4 books to take home and add to their personal libraries.
- A total of 49,530 Mystery Science lessons were assembled and distributed to 134 classrooms.
- 717 3rd grade students in the Campbell Union School district participated in an online Inquiry & Innovation STEM presentation and each child received an easy-to-read science related book.
- Volunteers purchased 422 new jackets, 256 pairs of shoes, 528 pairs of socks, 21 school uniforms and 50 hygiene kits for distribution to students in 10 schools.
- 5 West Valley College STEM students were selected to receive \$1,000 Scholarships per student and 10 Science Camp Scholarships of \$1,000 each were awarded in the Moreland School District.
- 53 new moms and their babies received quilt bundles with layettes, toys and diapers to help them with a better start as a family and 85 first birthday bags, 79 baby shower gifts and 53 holiday gifts were delivered to those 53 families identified by SCC Public Health Nurses.
- 140 Care Kits with household and hygiene items were distributed to West Valley Community Services clients at the Park-It Market.
- 60 Foster Care Packages were distributed to local Foster Care students entering their first year of college.

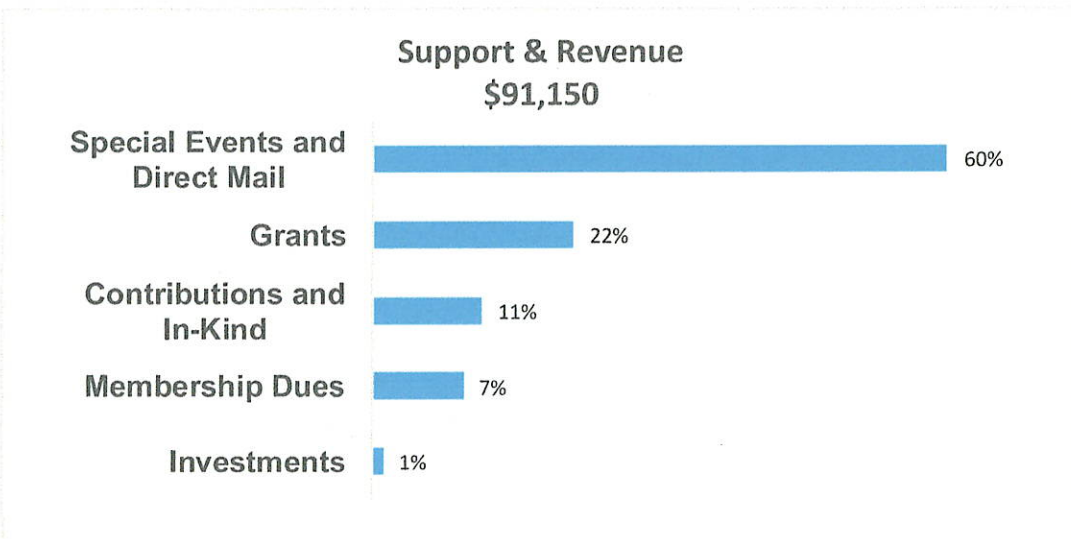
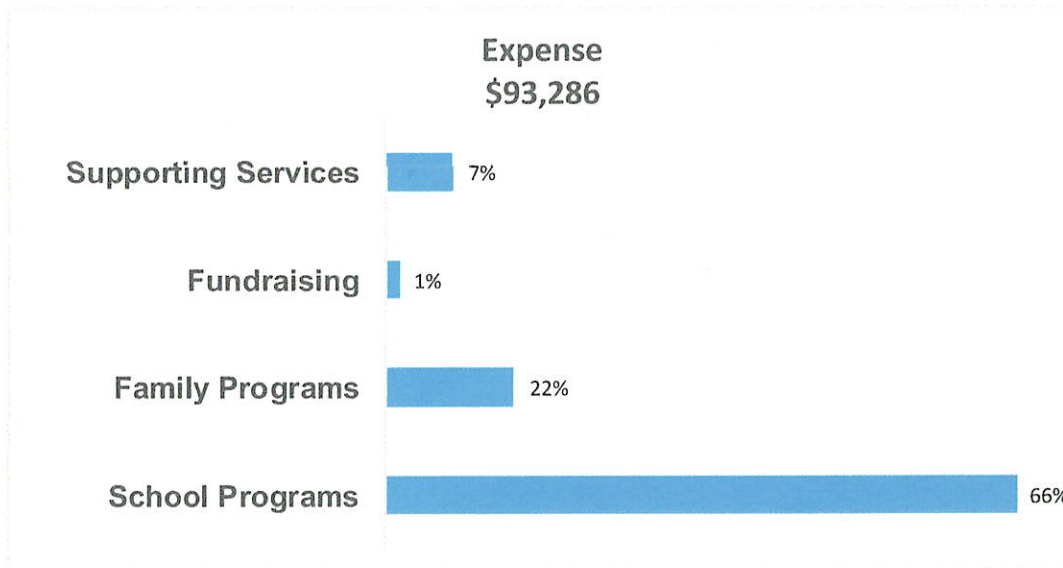
