



Community Impact Report

2022-2023

As part of a national organization of 120 chapters of Assistance League, our mission is to serve our local community with innovative programs to ensure those most in need are served directly.

Last year our members helped enrich the lives of school children and families in Los Gatos, Saratoga, Monte Sereno, Campbell and San Jose. Assistance League is an all-volunteer non-profit organization with no paid staff and minimal overhead.

2022-2023 Milestones

- Celebrated our 20th Anniversary as a chapter.
- Served more than **7,000** clients and contributed more than **11,417** volunteer hours.
- Invested more than **\$95,000** in our local communities.
- **91.9%** of every dollar spent was returned back to the community.

Accomplishments in 2022-2023:

- 1,824 books were distributed to 32 classroom libraries. Students were also given 4 books to take home and add to their personal library.
- 335 TK-2nd grade students participated in our Bee Bots Computer Robotics Programming Lesson.
- 717 3rd grade students in the Campbell Union School District participated in an Inquiry & Innovation STEM presentation and received a science-related book.
- Volunteers purchased 447 new coats, 302 pairs of shoes, 604 pairs of socks, 7 school uniforms, and 6 backpacks for distribution to students at 18 schools.
- 5 West Valley College STEM students were selected to receive \$1,000 per student, while 56 Science Camp Scholarships were awarded.
- 64 new moms and their babies received quilt bundles with layettes, toys and diapers to help them with a better start as a family. In addition, 32 birthday bags, 75 shower gifts and 92 holiday gifts were delivered to families in need.
- 488 Care Kits with household and hygiene items were distributed to West Valley Community Services' clients.
- Volunteers planned, cooked, and served 1,540 lunches to seniors at the Saratoga Senior Center.
- Volunteers purchased requested items for Pivotal Foster Care youth transitioning to 4-year colleges and provided holiday bags and packages for graduating seniors.

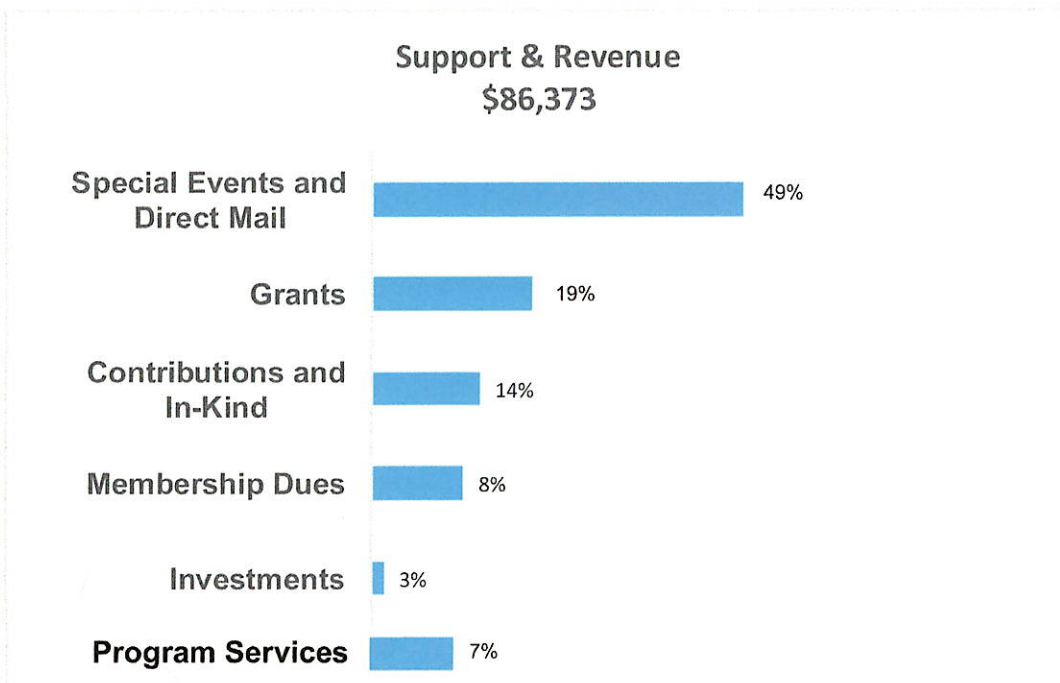
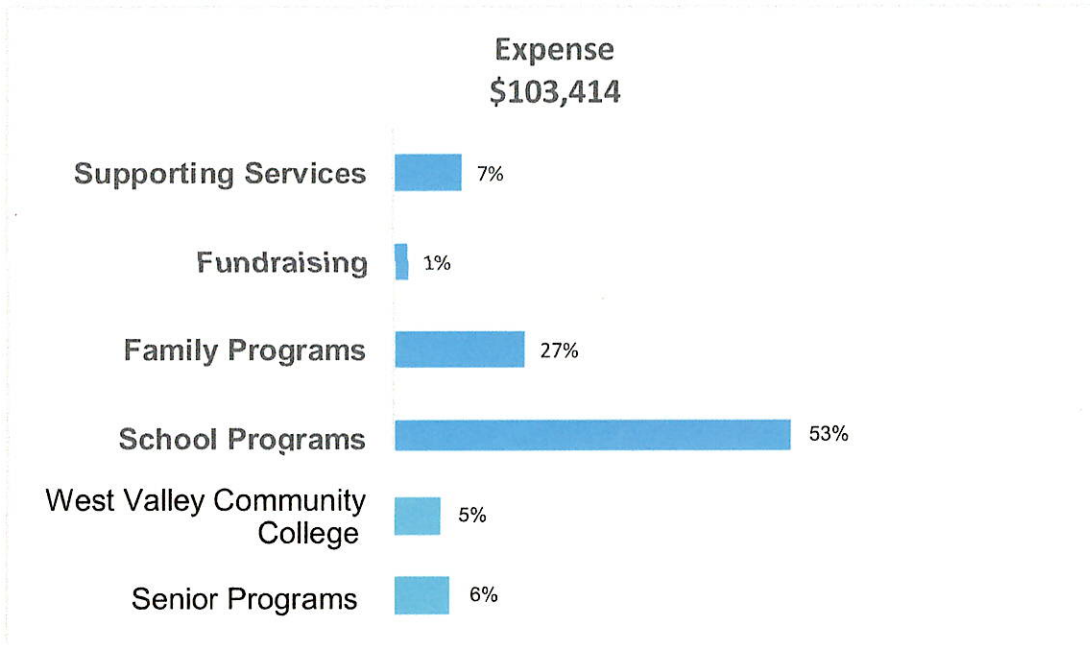
