2024-2025

As part of a national organization of 120 chapters of Assistance League, our mission is to serve our local community with innovative programs to ensure those most in need are served directly.

Each year our members helped enrich the lives of school children, seniors and families in Los Gatos, Saratoga, Monte Sereno, Campbell and San Jose. Assistance League is an all-volunteer non-profit organization with no paid staff and minimal overhead.

2023-2024 Milestones

- Celebrated our 21th Anniversary as a chapter.
- Served more than **4,500** clients and contributed more than **13,350** volunteer hours.
- Invested more than **\$99,500** in our local communities.
- Returned **89.2%** of our income directly back into programs benefiting the local community.
- Formed a partnership with Assistance League of Los Altos to host an event at their League Shop and continue to support the Shop's fundraising efforts.

Accomplishments in 2023-2024:

- Volunteers read 352 books to student in 22 classrooms and gifted those books to the classroom library. Students also received 3 books for their personal libraries.
- 684 3rd grade students in the Campbell Union School District participated in an Inquiry & Innovation STEM presentation and received a science-related book.
- Volunteers purchased 493 new coats, 290 pairs of shoes, 794 pairs of socks, 24 hats, and 26 school uniforms for distribution to students at 19 schools.
- 55 Science Camp Scholarships were awarded.
- 42 new moms and their babies received quilt bundles with layettes, toys and diapers to help them with a better start as a family and 38 birthday bags, 63 shower gifts and 151 holiday gifts were delivered to families in need.
- 800 Care Kits with household and hygiene items were distributed to West Valley Community Services clients.
- Volunteers planned, cooked, and served 1,485 lunches to seniors at the Saratoga Senior Center.

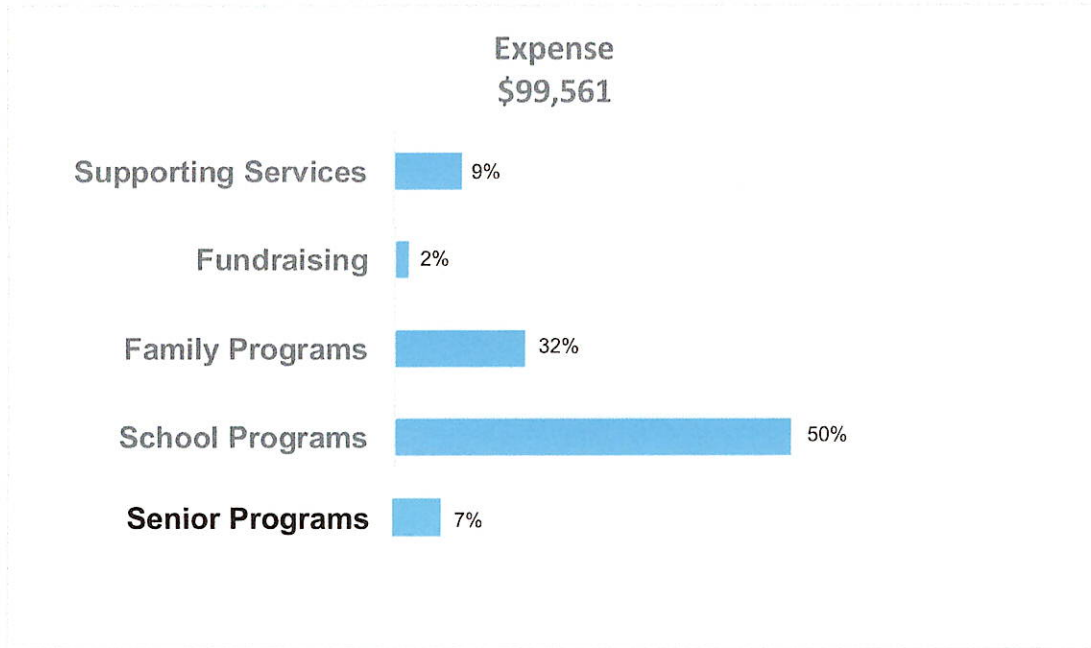
